Health & Safety Protocols -Sebastopol Documentary Film Festival

The 15th edition of Sebastopol Documentary Film Festival will be an in-person event, celebrating the art of documentary film from March 24 – 27, 2022 in Sebastopol, CA. Our entire community is looking forward to gathering together again around film, food and friends.

We are taking measures to make this event as safe and comfortable as possible for all who attend. Here are the current policies in place throughout the County, city of Sebastopol and SDFF venues.

- The [County of Sonoma](#) requires that everyone, regardless of vaccination status, wear masks indoors as an extra precautionary measure.
- Theatrical venues require proof of full vaccination and/or proof of a negative COVID-19 test taken within 72 hours of theater screenings along with a photo ID. These can be digital records or photocopies.
- For the health and safety of all visitors and staff, masks are required to enter and attend all indoor venues.

Those coming from international hubs will have their own travel requirements according to country and mode of transportation. Please check before making travel plans. The same is true of visitors from other states. Changes and alerts regarding Festival protocols will be kept current on the [SDFF website](#).
